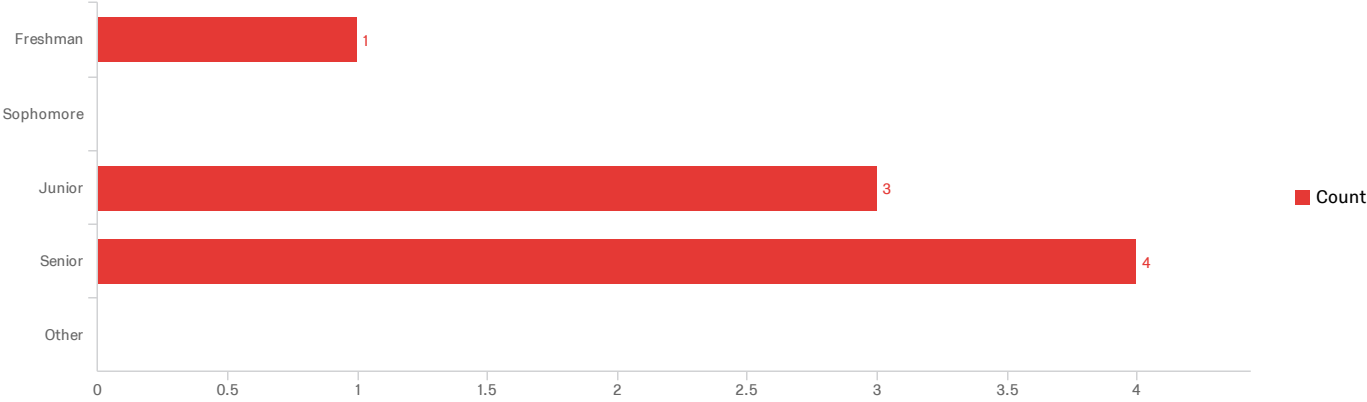

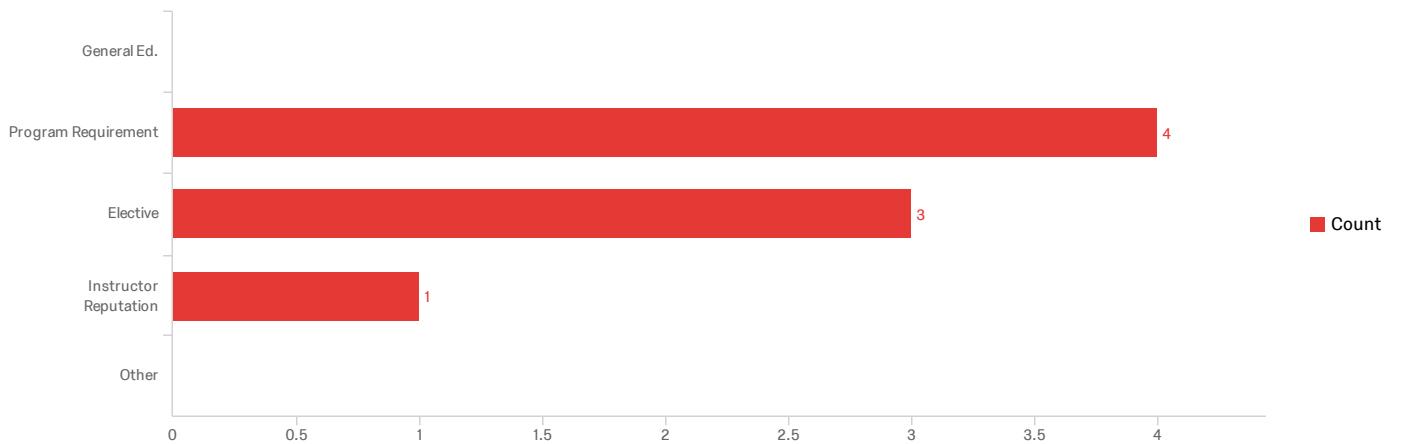

What is your primary reason for taking this course?

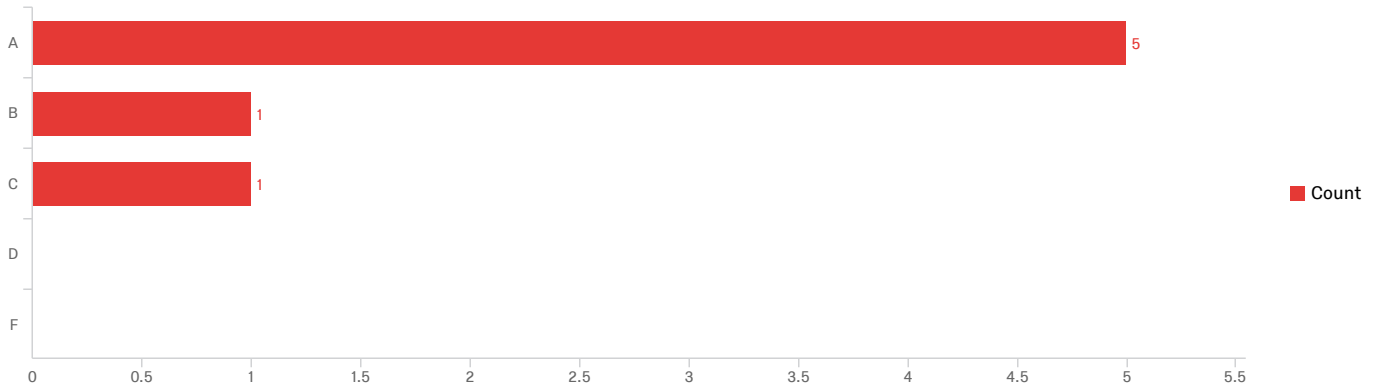
