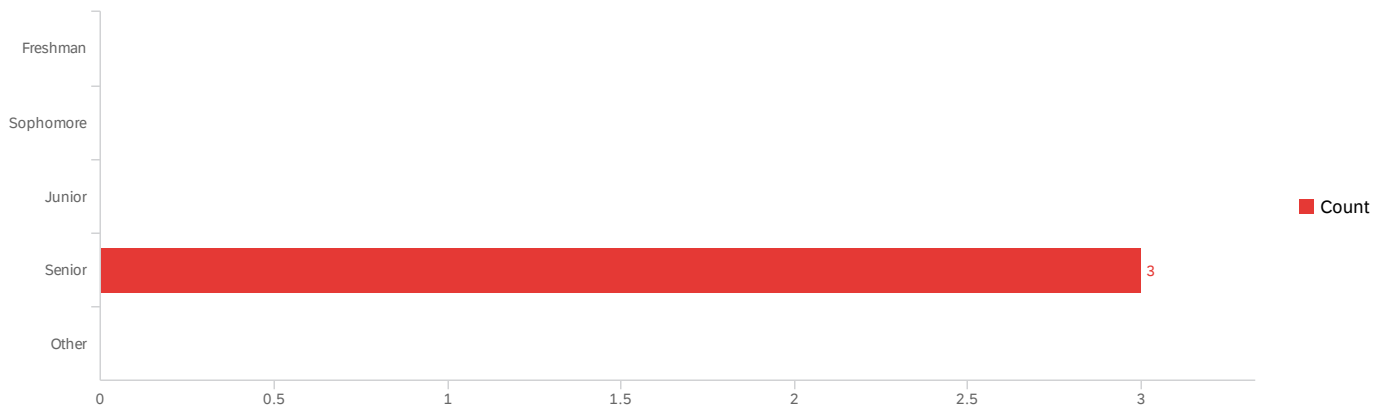

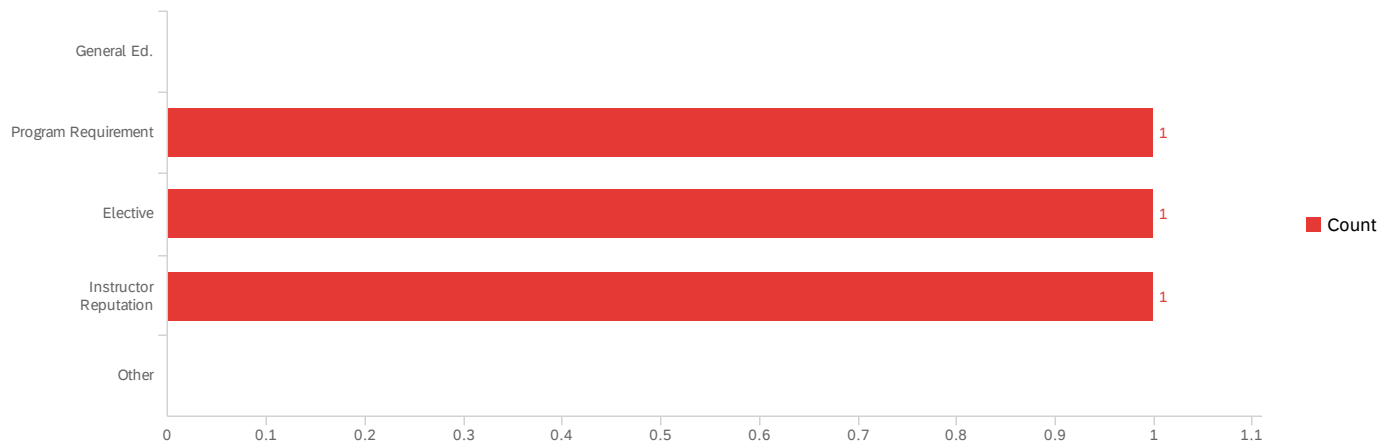

What is your primary reason for taking this course?

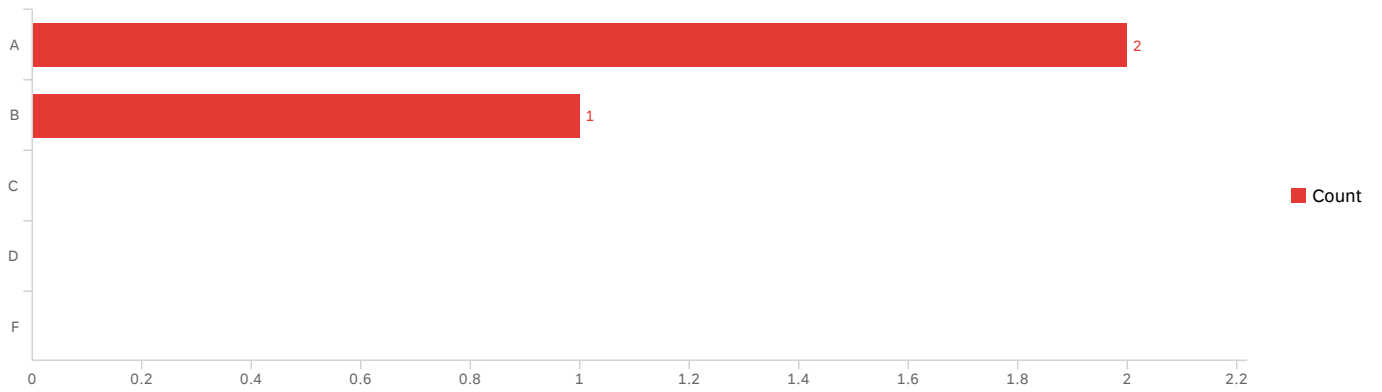

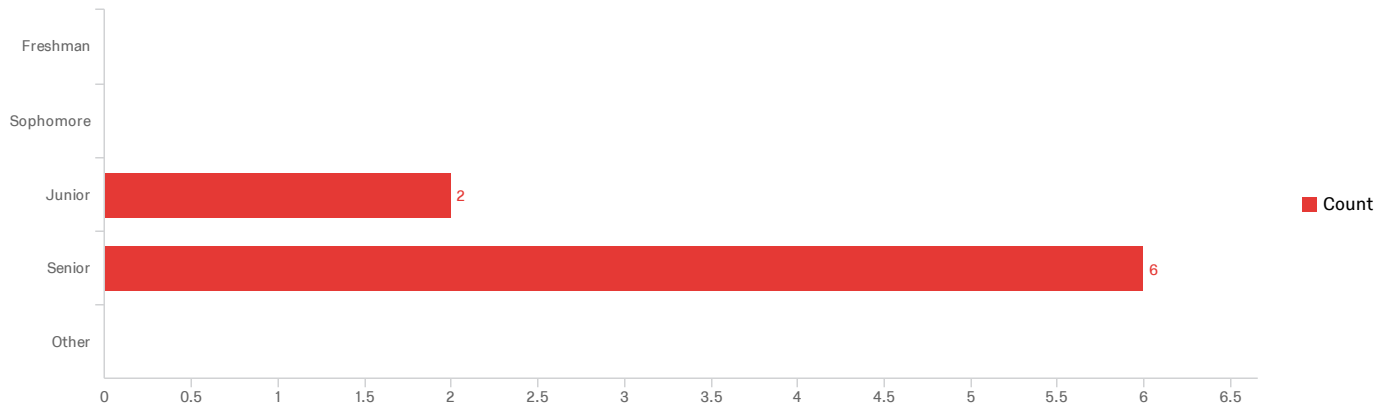

What is your class level?

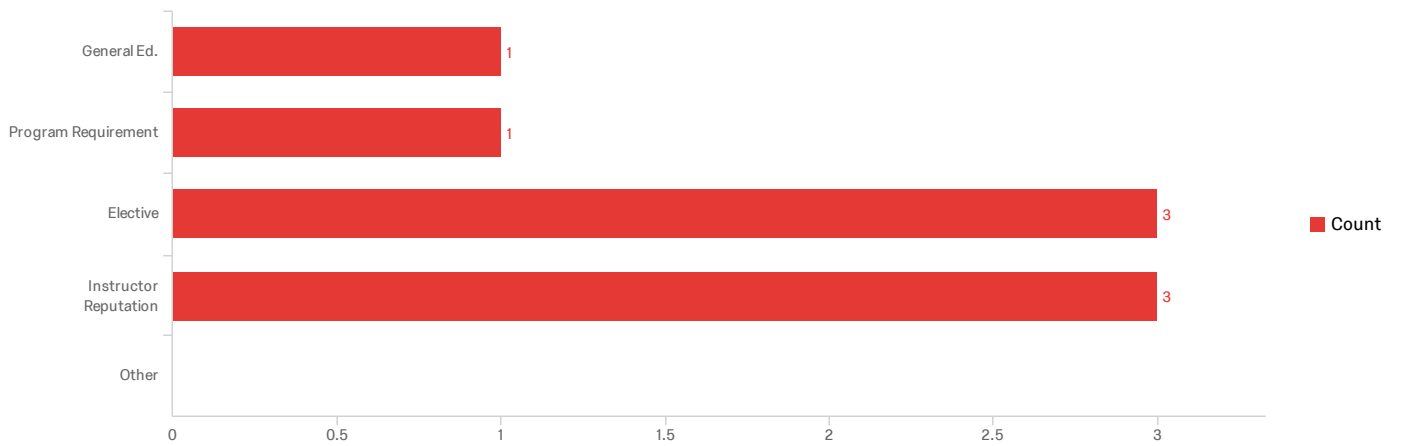

What is your primary reason for taking this course?

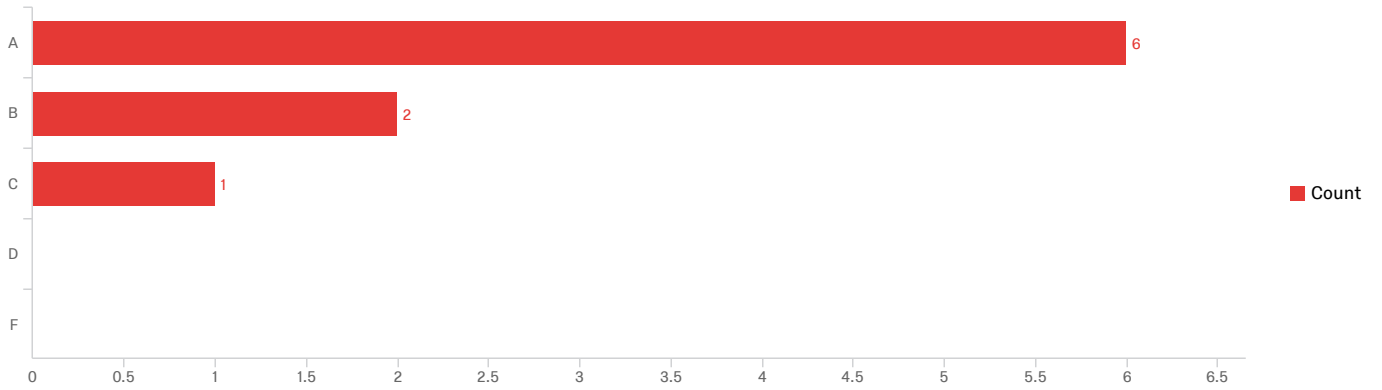

It would help with the equipment rental congestion that hits around week 6. Also it would give people's projects more time to form, once they realize all the planning that goes into production.

I think that next time we should start production sooner and get right into pre pro when class starts, encourage people to gather resources, cast, locations by the second or third week. Maybe come into the term with an idea and a rough script?

Given that this was the first time this course was run, Courtney did a great job. I think her design has a neat logic to it - make a short film and emerge from the 11 week course with a plan to market that film. There isn't sufficient time to do either of those parts particularly well and for a course called Workshop, there wasn't nearly enough group feedback sessions. During the few feedback sessions we did have, no one's project was given sufficient time to be worked on. I think anyone present for these sessions would agree that they were frantic, rushed and largely unproductive. I am a big fan of Courtney as a lecturer but I don't think this class needs readings or lectures. This class could be completely dedicated to making the projects. We could get into production weeks earlier and have sufficient time to do things right, give each other serious feedback and also regroup when something inevitably falls through or doesn't turn out right. Say we did spend 11 weeks completely devoted to making the films and helping each other, is it really conceivable that these 16 projects would end up shelved and unseen? I seriously doubt it. On the contrary, if our 16 projects were given sufficient time to be developed and produced, the quality of the work would be much higher and the motivation to market and release them would be a given. What would make the films better? I think that should be the central question as to how to improve this course. Reading assignments and arbitrary deadlines for deliverables do not make for better work. If you have 16 smart students and a brilliant teacher like Courtney working together to make everyone's project succeed for 11 straight weeks, I believe everyone will emerge with their best possible work.
